Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Install engines and compartments, pumps, tires, conduit and hydraulic lines, set pressures, etc. on very large equipment.
- Produce components by assembling parts and subassemblies
- Assemble and install parts, wires, hoses, and hydraulics onto large equipment utilizing power equipment and wrenching techniques
- Drill holes for wires, hoses and small parts
- Position parts and subassemblies by using and referring to blueprints
- Complete small weldments
- Install various equipment accessories (decals, mud flaps, cameras, lights)
- Lift and stack completed subassemblies and parts
- Train and work in various areas of assembly in response to production demands
- Follow verbal and written work instructions
- Pay particular attention to detail to ensure that quality standards are adhered to
- Regular attendance required throughout the program and subsequent employment
- All other duties and responsibilities that are assigned
