2nd Shift-2:00pm-10:00pm (\$0.45/hour shift premium)

3rd Shift-10:00pm-6:00am (\$0.60/hour shift premium)

Set-up, adjust & operate CNC Turning Center machines.

- Must know conventional programming.
- Will be required to tend multiple machines in a production mode.
- Required to keep maintenance and production logs.
- Works from blueprints, operation sheets, programs, specifications, and/or verbal instructions.
- Maintains tool and machine adjustments.
- Reset tools as required to produce parts within close limits where finish requirements are difficult to maintain.
- Check set-up and production parts using a wide variety of precision measuring instruments.
- Must be able to assist in optimizing a program to obtain best production and quality.
- Must be willing to attend classes and seminars for training on CNC equipment as directed by the Company.
- Accountable for process, evaluation, measurement, documentation and improvement on a continuous basis.
- Participate in department and process team activities and projects.
- Is expected to abide by all plant safety policies and procedures.
- Performs any other duties as assigned by the Department Manager or Leader.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High School diploma or equivalent plus short term trades training in NC or CNC programming (1 - 2 years).
2. Minimum 1 to 3 years machining experience in metal turning.
3. Qualified in S.P.C. and capable of using wide variety of measuring instruments.
4. May be asked to take a Mechanical Aptitude Test
