

Electro-Mechanical Maintenance Technician (Journeyman Electrician)

JOB DESCRIPTION:

- Responsible for the design, installation and maintenance of all plant electrical equipment and systems.
- Designs, installs, inspects and maintains all 440 volt and 110 volt circuitry.
- Recommends, approves and inspects all work and equipment associated with the 13,300 volt utility feed lines.
- Modifies machinery power circuits to make them compatible with facility feed lines.
- Tests, repairs and replaces electronic circuitry and components.
- Designs, installs and tests controls and cable systems.
- Troubleshoots all electrical equipment such as motors, transformers, controls, instruments, lights, heaters, etc.
- Establishes and maintains records on all electrical equipment.
- Inspects all electrical work to insure compliance with applicable codes.
- Trains and directs electricians.
- Accountable for process, evaluation, measurement, documentation and improvement on a continuous basis.
- Performs in department and process team activities and projects.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Department Manager or Leader.
- Is expected to abide by all plant safety policies and procedures.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High school graduate plus 4 years formal trades training or equivalent experience. Journeyman's license as an electrician preferred.
2. Must be able to read and use complicated drawings, diagrams and specifications.
3. Use electrical hand tools and associated electrical measuring devices. Experience with industrial equipment electrical systems, including P.L.C. controls and troubleshooting. Be familiar with the N.E.C.
