Through the NWTC Earn & Learn Program, participating manufacturers will have an opportunity to meet motivated students who have completed advanced manufacturing classes while in high school. Is your organization willing to:

- Offer a plant tour and/or career pathway discussion, or
- Offer a plant tour and/or career pathway discussion for parents and the student, or
- Speak at a high school about career pathways within your organization, or
- Participate in an NWTC on-campus event to discuss career pathways within your organization, or
- Participate in at least one Career Fair or similar activity during the school year, or
- Help with mock interviews, or
- Create a profile on Know.Career.com which will allow you to pre-screen all participating students
- Offer job shadow experiences to high school students, or
- Offer a position to a 2<sup>nd</sup> semester high school senior, AND
- Offer a position to the high school graduate, the summer after their graduation
  - Pay for their tuition and books for the NWTC credentials
  - Allow them to be a part-time student, and part-time employee
  - Provide commitment details to NWTC E&L Coordinator
- Participate in a "Draft Day" Celebration at Lambeau Field in May. This includes potential to be interviewed and/or showcased on live television or other media outlets.
