Position Responsibilities

- Perform predictive/preventive maintenance tasks on rotary screw compressors, reciprocating compressors, pumps, motors, fans, condensers, evaporators, chillers, hand valves, control valves, valves gangs, etc... as required within allotted time frame.
- Effectively evaluate operating conditions of refrigeration systems & equipment to maximize peak operating performance & make proper adjustments if required.
- Pump down/evacuation of refrigeration system(s) & equipment for construction/service projects.

- Capable of starting & operating a variety of new & existing refrigeration systems.
- Diagnostics and repair of electrical & electronic control systems & components.
- Communicate with customers effectively upon arrival and at completion of work so they know & understand what tasks are being performed & completed on their equipment.
- Complete all required paperwork & submit to Bassett Mechanical office daily; obtain customer signatures on service reports and attain approval for any extra/additional work.
