ACP PARTNERSHIPS MEETING – OCTOBER 26 | KI CONVENTION CENTER

Members recommended continuation of the ACP Partnerships meeting. The meeting will be held the afternoon of October 26. School counselors, administrators, and tech ed teachers will be invited to the roundtable discussions. Tania Kilpatrick shared that it may be beneficial to connect with the New North CESAs to include some of the ACP learning targets. Tania will share the ACP targets at the next meeting on 8/20/2021.

STUDENT EXPERIENCE EVENT | OCTOBER 27 | 8:30 TO 11:00 AM

Traditionally, 500+ students have been bussed to the MFEC's KI Convention Center for career exploration and to listen to the keynote speaker's student presentation. Due to COVID, the large number of students will not be attending in-person this year. However, Dr. Rigsby, this year's keynote speaker, has an inspirational story and is allowing the recording of his message for schools. Educators will have a limited timeframe to share the presentation with their students.

A discovery event, for up to 100 juniors and seniors, is being planned that will offer hands-on experiences at the KI Convention Center. Because the event is at the beginning of the school year (10/27/2021), it will not be a competition, as most students are not ready to compete this early in the school year. 8 to 10 employers could each provide a hands-on experience(s). LAB Midwest is also interested in participating. Other possible hands-on experiences could include CNC machining, electro-mech, wiring circuits, welding, and automation. Companies would be encouraged to give-away logo items to the students. Event t-shirts will also be given to the students. Members will finalize the event at the next meeting on 8/20/2021.

SEAPERCH

The North Coast Marine Manufacturing Alliance (NCMMA) hosted a virtual boat build last spring and will be hosting a similar build in October for up to 150 students. These boat builds help spark interest in the marine industry and serve as a precursor to the NCMMA's underwater robotics SeaPerch Competition.

2022 TECH ED TEACHER SUMMIT

The Alliance has hosted events that unite educators with industry for firsthand learning. It may be time to invite tech ed teachers to a summit to partner with them on what they need from industry and get their viewpoint on how to engage students. Many of these educators serve as an influencer to help students find a job. The Alliance, with assistance from some sponsors, could offset a ½ day sub cost for educators to attend the event. Task Force members agreed that a spring 2022 event would be beneficial to plan.

The Alliance is working to continue its tradition of hosting tech ed teachers in the summer for a 2 day exploration of a transportation related manufacturing company. Past years included:
