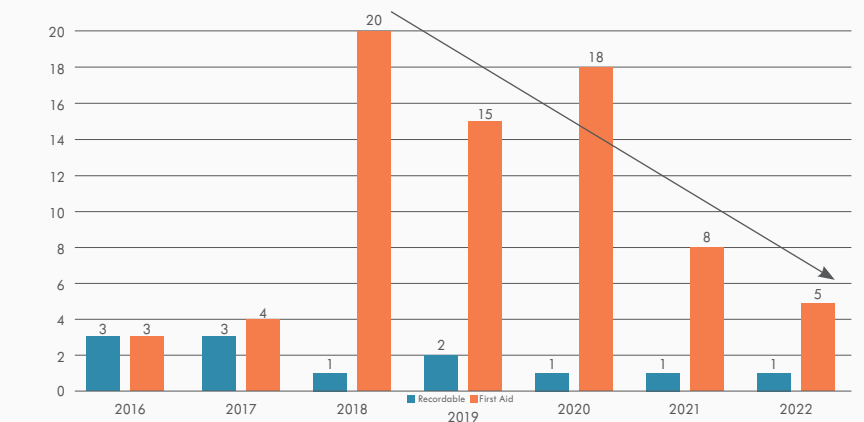
Case studies

Through a five-year partnership, an engineering company worked with Prevea Corporate Health & Wellness to improve the health and well-being of employees and decrease the risk of injury. Together, they reduced the total number and cost of work-related injuries.

DECREASING WORKERS' COMPENSATION COSTS

Utilizing professional movement and lifestyle assessments and through the implementation of on-site care teams coupled with high employee engagement, injuries were addressed before they became OSHA recordables. And with proper and expedited treatment, workers' compensation costs were reduced.

Sprain/strain-related incidents requiring **first aid steadily declined with a 75% decrease** from 2018 to 2022.



Workers' compensation **costs declined by 97%** from \$226,221 in 2016 to \$7,000 in 2021.
